GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT RESEARCH AWARD

SUBMISSION DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 25, 2010

1. The principal author of a submitted paper must be either:

- (a) a student member of AASP
- (b) a regular member of AASP or
- (c) have submitted an application for student or regular membership.

If the principal author is or has applied to be a regular member, he or she must have been a student, and must have conducted the research upon which the submitted paper is based, within two years prior to submitting the paper. A paper may have multiple authors, as long as the principal author meets the aforementioned criteria.

2. If the principal author is a student, he or she must be enrolled in an approved school psychology program. If the principal author is not currently a student, he or she must have been enrolled in an approved school psychology program within two years prior to submitting a paper.
3. A **certificate and monetary award** for the winning paper will be given only to the author or authors who are either: (a) AASP student members or those who have applied for student membership, or (b) regular members or those who have applied for membership and who were students during the time in which the submitted research was completed. In the event of multiple authorship, each AASP member, or candidate for membership, will receive a certificate, and the monetary award will be divided equally among them.
4. A paper must conform to the latest edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association related to manuscripts. The paper must include an abstract, must be typed and double-spaced, and must not exceed 25 pages. Five copies of the paper must be submitted to the Research Committee chair by the deadline stated in the call for papers.
5. A paper may be in submission to a journal or other publication, but it may not already be published or in press. It must be indicated if this research has been presented at any previous conference or workshop.
6. Applicants may be requested by the AASP Executive Board to present their papers/posters at an AASP Conference. Requests for presentations will be made at least one month prior to the Conference to allow sufficient preparation time.
