



Arizona Association of School Psychologists Call for Nominations

In order to run for an office, the nominee must be an active member of the Association. The responsibilities of each officer are defined in the bylaws. Please help keep our association strong – nominate an active AASP member for one of the positions. Also, please remember to ask the nominee prior to submitting anyone's name. Short descriptions of the positions follow. **Nominations Close on March 1st.**

President-elect (1 year term)

This position is really a three year commitment for leadership: President-elect, President, and Past President. The President spends this first year becoming familiar with the operations of the Association. As President, he/she also serves as the Program Chair to oversee arrangements for the annual conference, with assistance from Committee Chairs. The President serves as chair of the board and executive meetings and coordinates agendas for these meetings.

Secretary (2 year term)

The Secretary is a member of the Executive Board and Executive Leadership Committee, attends meetings of these groups, accordingly and has voting rights. The secretary accurately records all association proceedings, including writing minutes of all Executive Board and Executive Leadership Committee meetings and shall perform all other usual and customary duties of a secretary. The secretary is responsible for maintaining the book of association policies and the Procedures Manual, ensures that all policies and procedures of the association are implemented and reviews initiatives of the association to assure completion.

Regional Director (2 year term)

Regional Directors serve as members of the Executive Board and attend quarterly board meetings. They participate in the policy making of the organization and bring recommendations from regional members. Further, the Regional Directors shall maintain contact with the members from their region, thus serving to facilitate the flow of information between the Executive Board and its members. Regional Directors shall promote membership growth in their region. Regional Directors are responsible for conducting a workshop or seminar in their region at least once every other year.

It is the right and responsibility of each AASP member to participate in the nomination and election process to select prospective leaders. Please submit nominations for the office of President-elect, Secretary, and Regional Director. Nominees for all offices must be current members of AASP. Please contact your nominees and secure their permission before placing their names in nomination. You may place your own name in nomination. Photocopies of this form are acceptable; **however, the signatures on each form must be original.**
