AASP is thrilled with Governor Ducey's new [Safe Arizona Schools action plan](#). In his plan, the Governor recognizes that children have the right to feel and be safe in their classrooms. AASP is particularly supportive of the focus on increasing mental health care in schools as well as increased training and support of school resource officers. His proposal calls for common sense changes to our state laws regulating access to firearms as well. AASP also wants to provide information for you to get started or continue with your crisis and trauma preparedness. These three online, free trainings are great for before or follow up after PREPaRE training. PREPaRE doesn't go into depth on shooter training, psychological first aid, or individual and small group treatment for children with PTSD. These are often follow ups to PREPaRE but they need not be. You can do these first. It will get you on the road to being prepared!

Complete FEMA Online Course (CEU): Introduction to ICS for Schools (IS-100.SCa for Schools) found at: <http://www.training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-100.SCa>

This online learning activity is free. It was developed jointly with the US Department of Education to provide specific training on the Incident Command System and structure for K-12 school providers. The material in this lesson corresponds to the foundation of the response and management structure described within the PREPaRE Model. You will learn the history and vocabulary of the Incident Command System as well as the structure and elements of this system as applied in schools. This learning activity culminates in an online exam for which you will need to procure a FEMA SID (student ID). Within 1-2 business days following your completion of the online exam you will receive an email with notification of your certificate for your records.

Complete FEMA Online Course (CEU): This is a free, 1-hour online, FEMA Active Shooter training. Successful completion of the exam leads to the IS-907 certificate. You will use the same FEMA student ID as the above assignment to take this course and complete the associated test. Training is available at:

Complete the Psychological First Aid Online Modules (6 CEU Credits + 1.5 CEUs for school supplement): These free online training modules bring to life and illustrate the Psychological first aid for schools: Field operations guide, 2nd Edition. To complete this free training you will need to create a new user account at the National Child Traumatic Stress Network at <https://learn.nctsn.org/>

You supplement the 6 hour training with a follow up on application in schools. The account and training are free. You earn a CEU certificate for this training.

Complete the Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools Online Training (training in two parts): This is free online training modules that bring to life and illustrate the CBITs Evidence-Based trauma treatment protocol for school settings. To complete this free training you will need to create a new user account at <http://cbitsprogram.org/> The account and training are free. You earn certification and CEUs for completing the two parts of the training. You get the manual for treatment download free. All resources are free. CEUs for part 1 is 2 hours. CEUs for part 2 is 5 hours.

Arizona has several qualified PREPaRE curriculum trainers that you may contact to secure training within your district.
